HORSE SHOW RULES

1. Proof of negative Coggins and Rabies on ALL HORSES is required within one year of date of the show, to save time, please send copies with pre-entries.
2. Guilford Fair or any person connected with the planning of this event will NOT be held responsible for any accident or injuries to horse, rider, spectators or property.
3. The show committee reserves the right to split, combine or cancel classes.
4. One horse, one rider combination to earn points in a division. You do not have to enter every class in your division to qualify for day end awards. In the event of a tie, the points from the Equitation class will be used to break it.
5. Any protest, please see the show manager, anyone approaching the judge without consent of the show manager will forfeit their points for the day. **THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.**
6. There will be a 2 minute gate call in effect,. If you need a hold on any class, please let the show booth know at least two classes in advance. Once the judge has started a class, you may not enter.
7. Any horse that is out of control or posing a danger may be asked to leave the ring or show grounds. In the same regard, any exhibitor or spectator causing a disturbance will be asked to leave the show grounds.
8. Known kickers **MUST** wear a **RED** ribbon in their tail.
9. Any Walk Trot rider or Green Horse caught cantering or lopeing on the show grounds **WILL BE DISQUALIFIED** and lose their end of day points.
10. Attire must be appropriate to the seat being ridden, shoes or boots with a heel must be worn. **NO SNEAKERS OR FLAT SOLED SHOES.** We encourage **ALL** riders of any age or seat to wear an approved helmet.
11. To save time please try to pre-register. You do not have to pre-pay when you pre-register however you must leave a check or cash for your classes before you enter the ring.
12. There will be a \$25.00 fee for any returned checks.
13. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes and end of day champion and reserve champion ribbons will be awarded.
14. Please bring a muck fork and a bucket to clean up around your trailer! **THANK YOU!**

DIVISIONS

BEGINNER :Any rider age 17 years and under that DOES NOT canter or lope, any beginner caught cantering on show grounds will lose their end of day points.

YOUTH: Any rider age 17 years and under that DOES canter or lope

ADULT: Any rider 18 years or older that DOES canter or lop

ADULT WALK TROT: Any rider 18 years and older that DOES NOT canter or lope, any walk trot rider caught cantering on show grounds will lose their end of day points.

GREEN HORSE: Any age HORSE in their first or second year of showing under saddle that DOES NOT canter or lope, GREEN HORSES may not enter any other division. If any GREEN HORSE is caught cantering on show grounds will lose their end of day points.
